## **SPEED Limit!!**

Winter is over and many people are getting out to enjoy our nice spring weather! Please be sure to slow down and pay close attention while driving in our neighborhood as we have many children playing, biking, walking, etc. Also be mindful of your speed in the early mornings and later in the evenings for neighbors and their four legged friends out exercising!

## **Covenant Reminder**

The RHA Covenants help to ensure that our neighborhood continues to attract wonderful families and our homes hold or increase in value. We all play a part in keeping our neighborhood looking good. Your attention to these details benefits everyone.

1. Trash can(s) need to be properly stored in the backyard or hidden by a fence. Trash cans should not be seen from the street. Trash can(s) need to be stored in a timely manner after trash pick up.
2. Trailers, boats, jet skis, RV's, etc. are not to be stored on your property for more than 72 hours.
3. Vehicle has been parked on street for more than 24 hours and has not been driven.
4. Yard: tall grass/weeds, trees need to be trimmed or removed if dead, curbside has excessive leaves, etc.
5. Other items such as: piles of dead branches in yard that need to be removed, untidy yards, storage of furniture, sports equipment, tools on front porch or yard are not acceptable standards.

## **Safety for Your Home & Neighborhood**

Crime inevitably tends to increase during warmer weather. With summer just around the corner, please be sure to take the following safety measures for yourself and for our neighborhood:

- Be sure to keep porch and coach lights on all night.
- Be sure to park cars in garage or driveway – not on the street.
- Always remove any valuables from your car and keep your vehicle locked at all times.
- Be aware of activity taking place around your home, your neighbors' homes as well as when you drive in the neighborhood.
