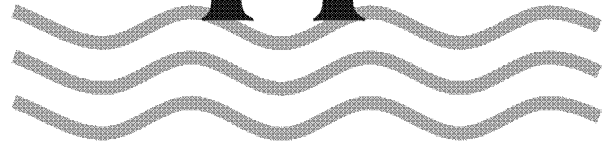

SWIM TEAM TIMES & NEWS

The Rockwood swim team season will begin on Tuesday, May 31. Practices are held weekday mornings at 8-9 a.m. for nine and ten year olds; from 9:15-10 a.m. for those age 8 and under; and from 7-8 a.m or from 10-11 a.m. for "seniors" (age 11-18). Swim meets are held on Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings in June and early July. *There is a fee of \$70 per child.* Contact the pool office to sign up.

SIGN-UP FOR SWIM LESSONS

You may sign up for swim lessons at the pool office. Session 1 lessons times are 11:15 a.m. to 12 p.m., Mon.-Thur., June 6-16. A fee of \$35 per child will cover the entire 2-week session. Session 2 will be offered June 20-30; Session 3: July 5-14; Session 4: July 18-28.

If group lessons don't fit into your schedule, we also offer **private swim lessons**. *The cost is \$60 for 4-30 min. lessons.* Contact the pool office, 685-3231.

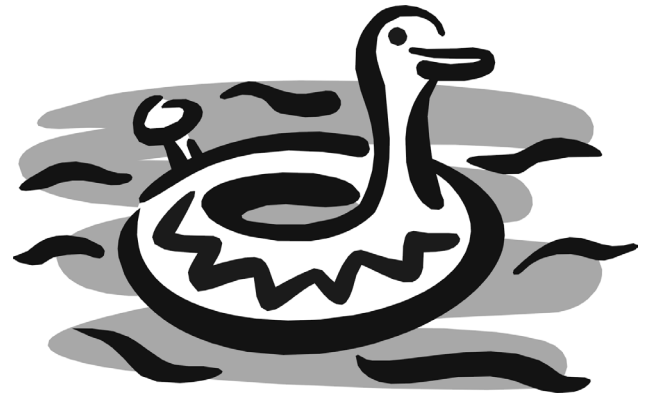

ROCKWOOD SAFETY BREAKS

Many pools have a mandatory 10-15 minute safety break every hour, every day. It is Rockwood's policy to only use a safety break on days where the heat index is 100 degrees or higher. On those days you should expect a 20-minute safety break to occur around 3 p.m.

The safety break is designed to give kids an opportunity to calm down and acknowledge their fatigue level, get something to drink, use the restroom, and get a break from the possible ongoing ingestion of pool water. This helps to reduce the chance of dehydration as well as fecal & vomit accidents.

Patrons 18 years of age and older may remain in the shallow end of the pool for recreational swim. Lifeguards will be busy refilling the ice & water coolers, hosing off the decks, and serving customers at the concessions window and front counter during the safety break.



SMOKING POLICY

Smoking is not permitted on the pool deck, in the baby pool area or in the beach area. We ask that you smoke only on the exterior flagstone patio on the west side of the patio room. A cigarette receptacle has been provided for you to dispose of your cigar and cigarette butts. Thank you for your cooperation!

WHEN THE WEATHER DOES NOT COOPERATE

Inclement weather may necessitate early closure or delayed opening of the facility. Such conditions may include heavy or persistent rain, air temperatures below 70 degrees, lightning and severe storm warnings.

If lightning is spotted, the pool will be cleared for 30 minutes. If another lightning strike is spotted during that 30 minutes, the clock will be restarted. The same is true if thunder is heard.

If in doubt, please call ahead (685-3231). Our first priority is patron and staff safety.
